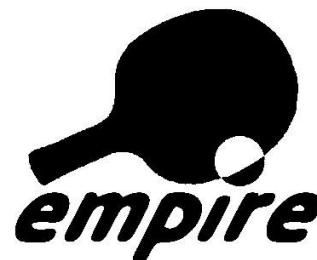


INTERCLUB FACT SHEET

Table Tennis Wellington (TTW) runs three interclub competitions each year as outlined below.



Summer Interclub (7 weeks from late February – early April)

This competition is run on Wednesday evenings from 7.00pm at the Empire Stadium. This is a more social competition with two sections. The A section consists mainly of Premier 1 and 2 grade players. The B Section is for lower grade players.

Winter Interclub (May – July and July - Sep)

This is run on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings from 7pm at both the Newtown and Empire Stadiums.

Premier One Grade

This is made up of the best 8 teams from around the association. These teams play one round over seven weeks, after which a new draw is created. After the holiday break a second round of seven weeks is played followed by semi finals and a grand final.

Premier Two Grade

The next best eight teams from around the association. Format is similar to Premier 1 without the semis and finals.

Premier Three Grade

Teams play one complete round during May-July. After the holiday break new entries are called for and a separate competition is run.

B Grade

As for Premier 3. The number of rounds depends on the number of teams entered. Other grades may also be run if there is enough interest.

Composite Teams Competition (Nov – Dec)

This is a five week competition between teams made up of players from different clubs.

General

Eligibility

In order to be eligible to play in any of the Interclub competitions players must be a member of the club. Players wishing to participate advise the club's interclub selector of their availability. Players are then allocated to teams and teams are submitted to TTW. Players are notified of their team and the draw. Players who are interested but unable to commit to playing every week can be a reserve.

Cost

2009 Interclub charges are as follows:
Adults \$8 per night, beneficiaries/tertiary students \$7 per night, school juniors \$6 per night.

Dress

Players must wear the club's uniform shirt for all interclub matches. These come in a range of sizes from XS-XXL and can be purchased at the kiosk for \$35. Empire players are also required to wear black or dark blue shorts, skirts or trousers.

Equipment

Two balls will be provided by the club to each team captain prior to interclub starting. Bats: Only approved brands of bats and rubbers will be permitted. Rubbers must be red on one side and black on the other. Gluing of bats is not permitted in the Newtown or Empire stadiums.
