Fees

A reminder please that **Multicards** are a member only benefit and are not transferable. They can only be purchased by a club member for their own use - please do not purchase on behalf of others. Multicards are generally available, and if they have run out at one particular club session, they are usually there at the next. Casual players on Sundays and Thursdays are not eligible to use multicards, although members attending the Sunday session can use their card. Hope this clarifies card use.
